#### **Welcome and Introductions**

# **Workgroup Updates**

#### **Child Care**

Ms. Redondo states that the Family Child Care Network is sitting at 102 members. The team is still recruiting via cold calls and social media updates. The workgroup is planning an event with MHMR Tarrant County. MHMR Tarrant County has multiple programs for teens and parents. Their funding covers Denton County. This event will be a demo parent café to show case managers what they can bring back to their clients.

# **Economic Mobility**

Ms. Redondo states that because of the two-week turnaround between leadership team meetings this group did not have a chance to meet but will set a date for September.

# **Leadership Team Updates**

### Homelessness

Ms. Adams updates the group on behalf of Ms. Williams. Ms. Adams shares that the homelessness initiatives team is going out to do Point In Time (PIT) count results to the community. She also shares that the Senior Rental Assistance program is moving along rapidly and they have assisted 35 unduplicated seniors with 292 months of gap rental assistance totaling under \$25,000. The Mortgage Assistance program closed at the beginning of this month expending \$145,000. The Barriers Fund has expended \$80,000 on 109 households and has \$13,000 remaining for City of Lewisville residents. UWDC hosted the first Collective Community Onboarding with 35 non-profit staff members in attendance from 14 different agencies across Denton County.

#### **Behavioral Health**

Ms. Spencer states that the leadership team has no updates. A few community members have a meeting scheduled to work with Dr. Stucky and staff around behavioral health.

### **Backbone Support Updates**

Ms. Redondo shares with the group a grant opportunity with AARP. The grant's purpose is to help senior 50 and older gain new skills to increase their income. She shares this would be a collaborative grant.



# **Public Comments**

Ms. Redondo reminds the group that United Way of Denton County's campaign kickoff breakfasts are just around the corner. Councilmember Troyer shares that City of Lewisville is hosting a Western Day weekend on September 16<sup>th</sup>.
